A nose of peach, apricot and honeysuckle moves to a dry palate with passion fruit, honeyed lemon and orchard fruits. (1) 12.5% vol
- 15 **Calasole Vermentino Rocca di Montemassi 2017/18, Tuscany, Italy** Btl £25.95
Elegantly balanced aromas of citrus, green melon and white blossom. The palate is silky, with mouth-watering green apple, citrus and stone minerals that lead to a long and refreshing finish. (1) 12.5% vol
- 16 **Agustinos Estate Pinot Gris 2017/18, Bio Bio Valley, Chile** Btl £21.95
A delicious example of this popular grape variety (more commonly seen as Pinot Grigio). Aromas of fresh red apple and ripe quince fruit. The palate is fresh and balanced. (2) 12.5% vol

| 23 | Lost Weekend Chardonnay Hesketh 2017/18, <i>South Australia</i>
Fragrant scents of honeydew melon and fresh peach, with seamlessly integrated French oak. Crisp notes of nectarine with toast and brioche flavours on the finish make this an elegant and well-balanced wine. (2) 13% vol | Btl £26.95 |
| 24 | Vondeling Babiana 2016/17, <i>Paarl, South Africa</i>
A beautifully blended white with intensely complex aromas of sweet almond, sandalwood, cinnamon and rose petal opening up to wild honey, peach blossoms, pineapple and toasted cashew nuts. Full and fat on the palate with a taut mineral freshness and seamlessly integrated oak. (2) 14% vol | Btl £35.00 |
| 25 | Hamilton Russell Chardonnay 2017/18, <i>Walker Bay, South Africa</i>
Aromas of perfectly-ripened fruit and finest French oak. Flavours glamorously combine in a racy elegant style that is closely reminiscent of the finest white Burgundy. (2) 13.5% vol | Btl £50.00 |
| 26 | Saint-Aubin 1er Cru Les Murgers des Dents de Chien Gerard Thomas et Filles 2016/17, <i>Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France</i>
A concentrated palate revealing notes of honey, dried peach and spice. It has refined crisp acidity that suffuses the palate with minerality as it rolls out on the finish. (2) 13.5% vol | Btl £55.00 |

| 28 | Meursault 1er Cru Château de Blagny Louis Latour 2014/15, <i>Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France</i>

An abundance of intense berry fruits such as redcurrant, blackberry and blueberry. A subtle, floral peony fragrance lingers on the palate and combines with mineral notes and round, silky tannins to give a balanced glass with a lengthy, fruity finish. (A) 12.5% vol

Syrah is the star of Laurent Miquel's ninth generation family vineyards. Brilliance shows in its captivating spicy aromatic ripeness and its natural fruit freshness on the palate. (D) 13.5% vol
- 34 **Côtes du Rhône Rouge Colombo & Fille 2016/17, Côtes du Rhône, France** Btl £29.95
A bright and seductively fruity wine packed with red fruit characters, well-rounded tannins and balanced acidity. (C) 13.5% vol
- 35 **Regional Reserve Pinot Noir Yarra Valley 2018/19, Yarra Valley, Australia** Btl £27.95

A superb young Pinotage. The flavours of this unique South African cultivar show ripe plum and fruitcake all beautifully integrated and then finished with subtle oak for a lingering aftertaste. (C) 14% vol
- 45 **Avanti Malbec 2017/18, San Juan, Argentina** Btl £23.95
Fully ripe, intense and glossy. It is bright and silky with vibrant hedgerow fruits and layers of subtle berry and spice flavours. (C) 13% vol

- 47 **St. John's Road Blood & Courage Shiraz 2016/17, Barossa, South Australia** Btl £34.95
Vibrant, deep Barossa Shiraz in all its glory! Brooding dark plums, liquorice and chocolate abound in this rich and flavoursome wine. (D) 14% vol
- 48 **Château Sergant 2016, Lalande-de-Pomerol, Bordeaux, France** Btl £38.95
Accompanied by a rich bouquet and structure, its ageing potential is long-lived. The palate is full and balanced with notes of blackberry jam and caramel. (C) 14% vol
- 49 **Tiger Country McHenry Hohnen 2014/15, Margaret River, Western Australia** Btl £44.00
The wine combines three unusual grapes; Tempranillo, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Sauvignon and makes a new active fruit style, with spiced flavours and the perfect touch of oak. (D) 14.8% vol
- 50 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape Colombo & Fille 2016/17, Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône, France** Btl £52.00
A big wine intense colour, nose and palate. Ripe fruit and gingerbread spice with herbaceous notes. (B) 14% vol
- 51 **Rocca di Montemassi Zonin 2014/15, Tuscany, Italy** Btl £55.00
This superb, Tuscan is intense, ruby red with vivid garnet reflections. Complex aromas showing cherry, plum and currant, with notes of violet, eucalyptus, vanilla and sweet tobacco. Rich and elegant palate, fresh fruit with full and plush tannins leading to a long and mineral rich finish showing spicy, toasted notes. (D) 14.5% vol
- 52 **Château de Pez Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel 2013, St. Estèphe, Bordeaux, France** Btl £60.00
